



Leicester & District: Flyers grounded by Park

For Electric, Andy Searle played for the first time and captured five but his loss to Shirley Pickering in the end proved crucial, the latter picking up three from four, the same from the doubles.

Meanwhile, Casualties were beating Villagers 16-4 thanks to Ajay Lad undefeated as the doubles exponent with four from four in both singles and doubles. Support came from Ian Wetherly with five and Lucki Obi three. Gemma Hargrave and Matt Woolerton each won two for the Villagers.
