



Patterson conjures up a super Finn-ish

Mollie Patterson secured some eye-catching results on her way to a 14th-place finish at the Finlandia Open – the best English position.

Up against a mixed age-group field, the 15-year-old had victories against players ranked above her, including a superb seven-game win over world No 5 Cadet and European Youth Championships runner-up, Elizabet Abraamian of Russia.

Her hardest fight was arguably against fellow English player Lois Peake, coming from 3-1 down to win 4-3 – and taking the fifth game 18-16 in the process.

Emily Bolton was also in good form, including beating the fifth seed, Anna Kirichenko of the host nation, in four straight, and three times coming from behind to defeat Sweden's Erika Fronth. That helped her to 22nd place overall.

The third highest place was achieved by Denise Payet, who was 28th, with Megan Gidney 45th, Peake 48th, Evie Collier 59th and Charlotte Bardsley 66th.

Sam Mabey was the only English man involved and he finished in 34th place with a record of four wins and three defeats.
