The TTYA programme will continue to incentivise young people volunteering at table tennis clubs who log a certain number of hours towards different levels of awards.

Greg Yarnall, Head of Development & Volunteering at Table Tennis England, said: "It has been fantastic to see the enthusiasm shown by our Young Ambassadors. It's vital that the sport engages with young people, taking their views on board and harnessing their skills – as well as helping to take the pressure off existing volunteers."

In 2018–19, 22 Clubs and Leagues registered for the programme. Halton TTC are one of many clubs who have supported a Young Ambassador. Volunteer Mentor Karen Tonge MBE said: "It's great that Table Tennis England are supporting and recognising our young club volunteers, to help clubs to continue to grow and develop its membership base.
