The Tribe's members come from every corner of the world and they enjoy not only playing at all levels, but also welcoming beginners, engaging with a diverse community, developing personal skills and enjoying active companionship.

Not only does it cater for those who may not be able to or wish to attend traditional clubs, it has also acted as a launchpad for some who have gone on to register with more 'formal' clubs, showing that it can pay dividends for clubs to look to build connections with the Ping! community as part of their recruitment drives.
