



## Pitchford and Ho through in Hungary

Liam Pitchford is into the last 16 of the Hungarian Open, while Tin-Tin Ho has a doubles quarter-final to look forward to on Friday.

Pitchford, the ninth seed, made a fast start, taking the first game 11-2, but his opponent hit back in the second and again in the fourth before Pitchford pulled ahead to win 4-2.

He is up against Qiu Dang of Germany, who defeated Paul Drinkhall on his way to winning the Portugal Open last week, in the next round at 5pm UK time on Friday. [Click here to watch the match on itTV](#) (registration required).

Ho is playing alongside familiar partner Karoline Mischek of Austria, with whom she won last year's European under-21 gold medal. The pair won a tight first game 15-13 against seventh seeds Adriana & Melanie Diaz of Puerto Rico, which gave them the platform to go on and take the tie in three straight.

Their quarter-final is against second seeds Doo Hoi Kem & Lee Ho Ching of Hong Kong on Friday morning.
