



Medal for British pair Wong and Hursey in Sweden

Jasmin Wong joined Anna Hursey to win a doubles bronze for Britain and Connor Green put in the best singles performance at a busy Swedish Junior & Cadet Open, where Millie Rogove also won the consolation final.

Wong and Welsh star Hursey were seeded 11th for the Junior Girls' Doubles and made their way through the early rounds to face third seeds Liubov Tentser & Vlada Voronina of Russia in the semi-finals. They lost the first two games and, although they struck back in the third, they were ultimately beaten in four.

In a competition which saw no fewer than 21 English youngsters in action, three all-English pairs – Gemma Kerr & Rebecca Savage, Erin Green & Amy Marriott and Anaya Patel & Millie Rogove – won their opening-round matches but went out in the last 32.

The best result for England in the corresponding boys' event was when Peter Smallcombe & Maxim Stevens came from 2-0 down to beat the higher-ranked Emil Johnsson & Elias Sjogren of the host nation 3-2 (8-11, 8-11, 11-9, 11-7, 11-5) in the last 64. They went out in the last 32 to the ninth seeded pair.

Josh Weatherby, competing alongside Emile Joncas of Canada, reached the last 16 by virtue of a walkover win in the last 32. They were beaten by the 15th-ranked pair, from Sweden. Also in the last 32, Rhys Davies & Thomas Rayner went out to the top seeds, while Ben Piggott & Felix Thomis suffered defeat at the hands of the second seeds.

Connor Green beat two top-20 ranked European Cadet players on his way to the last 32 of the Junior Boys' Singles – overcoming No 20 Martin Froseth of Norway 3-1 (12-10, 10-12, 11-4, 11-8) in the group stage and then the No 14 David Bjorkryd of Sweden 4-3 (11-9, 9-11, 11-7, 11-7, 10-12, 6-11, 11-7) in the round of 64. Green, himself ranked at No 109 in the age group Europe, was defeated by 13th seed Jacobo Vahnish of Panama in the last 32.

Joe Cope, with two group victories, also made it through to the knockout stage, as did Peter Smallcombe on

countback with one group victory. They were both eliminated in the last 64, Smallcombe by 12th seed Nicholas Lum of Australia and Cope by 15th seed Nicholas Chong of Singapore. Maxim Stevens came close with three 3-2 defeats in the group stage.

In the consolation event, Weatherby reached the quarter-finals, including beating team-mate Davies in the last 16. Joseph Hunter also reached the last 16. Naphong Boonyaprapa, Piggott, Stevens, Thomis and Jakub Piwowar went out in the last 32.

In the Junior Girls' Singles, Wong won her three group matches to make the main draw, but was beaten 4-1 (11-9, 11-8, 6-11, 11-4, 11-7) in the last 64 by Maria Sirakova of the USA.

None of the other English girls made it through, though Millie Rogove, Erin Green and Anaya Patel all won one match and all narrowly missed out in deciding sets of other ties.

In the consolation event, Rogove went all the way to the final, with three 3-2 victories along the way. She only needed three to win the final, defeating Anna Pyaterikova of Russia 11-9, 13-11, 11-6.

Erin Green and Marriott reached the last 16. Patel, Kerr, Megan Jones, Anna Green and Savage went out in the round of 32.

The Mini Cadet events start on Friday, with the Cadets on Saturday, with several English players competing – Hunter, Piwowar, Connor Green, Thomis and Georgios Gerakios in the boys and Anna Green, Savage, Marriott and Jones in the girls. Piwowar is also in the Mini Cadet event.
