His excellent victories over Leo Long (Berks) and winner of the U13 event Harrison Simmons (Bucks) proved decisive. Jonah Stott had the tougher group, finishing 4th with 3/6, but he put in two superlative performances, in particular playing out a spectacular match with the best player on view, Daniel McTiernan (Berks; England no 4 U13), only going down 7-11, 12-14, 8-11.
