Jill was European champion and holds the record for most national women's singles titles with seven. She was awarded the MBE for services to the sport.

But she says she could not have achieved that without the support of numerous volunteers from her early days at the Slough British Legion club and all the way through her career.

Jill's husband Don, a Board member and former England player himself, added his voice to honour volunteers who help people to enjoy and achieve at all levels of our sport.

Contribution to Table Tennis and of course the Blue Riband Volunteer of the Year and Young Volunteer of the Year.

These will be presented at a gala dinner to be held at the National Conference in June 2021.
