"Since the launch of TT Kidz in 2019, the programme has grown significantly. Despite not being able to do any club delivery since March 2020, the TT Kidz team have been able to provide online content including live camps and after-school clubs as well as kit giveaways through partnerships with foodbanks.

"We have also introduced the TT Kidz Awards scheme, allowing children to chart their progress as they learn new skills which will underpin their table tennis participation.

"We look forward to sharing the success of the programme with the panel."
