- Give attendees the opportunity to input and shape the key actions and strategy

- Better understand where the sport is with regards to diversity and inclusion in the sport
- Ask questions about the current findings and conversations that have taken place so far
- Share your own experiences and learnings in this area
- Contribute to what will be included as key actions and the 'how' within the strategy
