The Great Britain table tennis squad has arrived safely in Japan ahead of the delayed Olympic Games, which open in Tokyo on Friday.

Liam Pitchford, Paul Drinkhall, Tin-Tin Ho, coach Gavin Evans and practice partner Tom Jarvis first joined the Team GB preparation camp in Yokohama and will move into the athletes' village on Tuesday.


