As Table Tennis England prepares its centenary programme, we are now calling on the table tennis community to get involved in the celebrations.

We are asking them to share their views through a short online survey which asks what the centenary could mean for the grassroots table tennis community around the country. Officials from leagues and counties should keep an eye on their email inboxes for a link to this survey.

We will also be asking clubs and individual members to share their ideas via an online conversation during August.
