

Free entry to Centenary English Leagues Cup Competitions

England's oldest table tennis competition has been renamed for our Centenary season – and leagues can now enter for free!

The Centenary English Leagues Cup Competitions (ELCC) is now open for entries. The event is open to Juniors and Seniors, with four trophies being contested. The Willmott Cup, first contested in 1935, is open to Senior men, with the JM Rose Bowl open for Senior women. That competition dates back to 1939.

In the Junior Competitions, the boys will compete for the Carter Cup and the girls for the Bromfield Trophy. All four competitions are open to affiliated local leagues, who will compete in zonal arounds in May. Preliminary rounds may be held before that, depending on the number of entries.

The finals will be held on the weekend of July 9-10 at Draycott & Long Eaton TTC. The closing date for entries is Monday January 24, 2022.
