France, having won the Junior Boys team earlier in the week, took all 4 semi final slots in the Junior Boys Singles and both Finalists in the Junior Doys Doubles also came from France. A totally dominant performance, Tristan Flore beat compatriot Quentin Robinot to take the Junior Boys Title having earlier lost the Junior Boys doubles partnering Enzo Angles they lost in five close games to Quentin Robinot and Simon Gauzy. Not to be outdone by the Junior Boys, France won the Cadet Boys Singles as well, Andréa Landrieu winning a tough 7 set battle

Romania had a good championships as well. Bernadette Szocs beat Petrissa Solja of Germany in another tight 7 game Junior Girls Singles final, and on Saturday evening Lucian Munteanu and Irina Ciobanu took the Junior Mixed Doubles.

The Cadet Girls Singles went to Germany's Nina Mittelham winning an all German final. Nina Mittelham combined with Nicole Trosman of Israel to take the Cadet Girls Doubles as well.
