Paul Drinkhall recorded excellent wins over Andrej Gacina (CRO, 58) and Yaroslav Zhmudenko (UKR, 98) 4-2 and 4-1 respectively while his partner Joanna Parker also upset the odds twice in wins over Yana Noskova (RUS, 82) and Katarzyna Grzybowska (POL, 101) both 4-2.

Liam Pitchford also continued his fine form to beat Spain's Carlos Machado (84) 4-1.
