Top Class Table Tennis Coming to Westfield

The competition is one of the oldest and most prestigious in the ETTA calendar. The origins of the competition go back to 1935 when Manchester won the Wilmott Cup (Senior Men). Exeter League were the first winners of the JM Rose Bowl (Senior Women) in 1939.
