This will then be screened on TV that evening. They are very keen to have Dave participating in activities on the day especially in a fencing bout and a table tennis session.

There may also be a World Record Rally attempt which would provide fantastic publicity for all involved – it's what all National Governing Bodies involved in London 2012 deserve.
