England number eight lady Lauren Spink and Men's national ranked number 30 Neil Charles will be amongst the hopefuls to stop Rumgay as will be Suffolk star Ryan Collins who won his first GP last season when beating Niall Cameron in last year's corresponding event.

Making a return to the area is Brazilian player Elson Costa who's pen hold grip makes him potentially dangerous while crowd pleaser Ipswich's Andrew Warner is sure to entertain.

With four groups of up to six players then banding events there are sure to be some thrilling matches.
