

Knighton Park excel in Rose Bowl

14-year-old Aman Rashid has been playing very well this season and spearheaded a good win for KP3 against Syston after KP had started 48 points to the good. Rashid finished on +38 while Patrick Carton had a decent return at +25 with the final score 335-268 to Knighton Park.

The third victory was obtained by KP5 who beat Regent Sports by 24 points after the teams started level. Shirley Pickering was in sparkling form with + 43 while Ashley Palmer, a promising junior, came up with + 25. Charlie Bateman with + 25 was Regent's best player.
