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Coach Licence Scheme

In addition to coaches achieving a relevant qualification to evidence they have the necessary skills and knowledge, it is essential that they also seek constant education, development and excellence in terms of knowledge and delivery. The Coaching environment is constantly evolving and changing; e.g. new coaching methods; changing equipment and techniques; cultural changes in society, etc., so coaches must keep up to date with these changes.

- DBS (Disclosure & Barring Service check) – Valid for 3 years
- CPD (Continuing Personal Development) – Valid for 1 year
