Meanwhile, Wymondham teammate and Captain Ian McLean praised the attitude of both McTiernan and Jared Patel, whilst also declaring that the British League offered young players an ideal platform to develop their game.

"It's been a pleasure to watch the youngsters that we've had this week. Their sporting credentials and sportsmanship has been incredible. I can truly see that whoever has been behind Liam and Jared in their career have been outstanding role models to them. They're respectful, graceful and they've been a credit to themselves, their clubs and their families.

"I think the players have grown into the role and Liam's result against Michael is proof that players should access this stage whenever possible because the development has been on display throughout the week."
