- 4 hour course

This course covers how to organise and deliver a wide variety of competition formats, venues and equipment.



[Table Tennis Networker Award](#)

- £15 per candidate + £120 tutor fees, plus travel at 37p per mile
- 6 hour course

This practically based course aimed at 15-19 year olds can be delivered as a bolt on to other courses.

1. Enable Young TT Networkers (leaders) to organise, safe, enjoyable and purposeful Table Tennis events.
2. Provide a lead into Table Tennis coaching, organising competitions, umpiring, table tennis officiating.



UKCC Level 1

- 16+
- £190 + safeguarding and first aid if required
- 3 days split over 6 weeks

Successful learners will be qualified to plan and deliver basic table tennis coaching activities. In addition to assessing your written course and home study work, a practical assessment is required.



Teacher Award

- Teachers/Student Teachers
- £35 per candidate + £120 tutor fees, plus travel at 37p per mile
- 6 hour course

This award is suitable for qualified or student teachers. It is mainly a practical course with a written assessment.



Disability Awareness in Table Tennis

- 14+
- £60-£120 tutor fees, plus travel at 37p per mile
- 3-6 hour course

A course designed to help teachers/young leaders to feel confident to make their table tennis clubs more inclusive.
