There will be an auction of creatively-designed table tennis bats which has been organised in collaboration with some of UK's best illustrators, designers and artists* and agency Fivefootsix.

The project, The Art of Ping Pong, has produced a series of one-off table tennis bats, which will be auctioned off for the Children in Need charity.

The auction opened on Friday November 8 and will run until Friday November 15, coinciding with the charity's televised appeal night.

All of the money raised through the auction of these bats (kindly supplied by Topspin Sports) will go to BBC Children in Need, who work year round to make a positive difference to the lives of disadvantaged children in the UK.

Some of the bats are currently up to £200, but a few are still available to snap up for just over £30 (if you're quick).
