Thompson, 25 from Cheshire, battled stiff competition in the class 11 singles keeping GB's medal hopes alive by beating Hong Kong's Ming Fai Tsoi in the quarter-finals to guarantee a podium appearance.

Doubles success eluded the British pair despite their victory in an exciting team game against number 3 seeds, Russia, where dynamic duo Thompson and Patrick Cox, 19 (Leicester), made their mark, but were then beaten to a commendable 4th place by the Hong Kong Team.
