Father and daughter Dexter St Louis and Rheann Chung have entered the Heritage Oil Open.

St Louis, world ranked 277 and the Trinidad & Tobago No 1 is a five-time Caribbean Men's Singles champion and competed at the Olympics in 1996 and 2008.

He has had a World ranking as high as 175 and has entered both the men's singles and the over-40s event.

His daughter Chung is also No 1 in her country and is ranked No 279 in the World. Both live in France and play in the professional French league.

Meanwhile, Spain's No 2 woman Galia Dvorak (WR 96), has also joined the field for the event. The Ukraine-born player competed at both the Beijing and London Olympics.

The women's competition is really warming up with a very strong field of 40 players, which is now full.
