Who is it for?

An Associate Membership is for club players, social players, officials and fans who wish to become affiliated with Table Tennis England, but do not want to take part in organised competition. It is part of the minimum requirements for people who wish to coach, umpire, referee, administrate or organise table tennis tournaments that they hold at least an Associate Membership.

In addition, it is a mandatory requirement for all [PremierClub](#) members to register as an Associate Member. This is because the insurance policy of the PremierClub is only valid for direct members of Table Tennis England and failure to do so could leave the club liable for damages and legal costs.

Alternatively, if you would like to play table tennis in organised competitive tournaments it is likely that you will need to purchase a [Player Membership](#) or a [Player License](#).
