Event: World Veterans' Championships, Over 60s-70s

Information: This was the first (and only) time that a Team Event was played at a Veterans' World Championships. Ellenborough A and B teams reached the semi-finals. There opponents were two Japanese teams, Young Cherry (two of their players were Kazuko Ito and Akiko Tosa) and Aitaku Aichi (Tsunek Tanabe and Miai Kato). I do not know which team were the champions.
