

Blue plaque tribute to inventor of 'table tennis' equipment

One of the pioneers of table tennis has been commemorated in his former home town.

July 15 was the 125th anniversary of the granting of a patent to David Foster for 'Improvements in Apparatus for Parlour Table Games' – equipment which was a fore-runner of the sport we now know.

A blue plaque was installed on his former home in Micklegate, Selby, by the local Civic Society, attended by past and present members of Selby Table Tennis Club.
