Kelly said: "Sport has given me so much, so I'm pleased to support this exciting initiative to get more people playing. And as a big fan of Coronation Street, I'm really looking forward to playing table tennis on the cobbles outside the Rovers!"

We are also looking for clubs around the country to play their part by opening their doors to new participants on the day.

Bishop Auckland Table Tennis Club are already committed to the initiative and have organised a Community Open Day with fun and games such as table tennis twister and a beat-the-robot challenge.
