England Leopards are returning to Stoke for their next home European Championships Qualifying tie – and tickets are now on sale.

Fenton Manor Sports Complex will once again be the venue as England take on The Netherlands on Tuesday March 7 (7pm), following their memorable victory over Greece in the same city in November.

That match saw England fight back from 2-0 down to win 3-2, in front of more than 600 spectators – with more than 2.2million watching at least part of the action on the SPORTbible Facebook page.

Table Tennis England Chief Executive Sara Sutcliffe said: "Our previous visit to Stoke was a great success, both in terms of the result and the event presentation. We look forward to working with the team at Fenton Manor to deliver another fantastic event."
