The prestigious award recognises single sport governing bodies or operators of a league or competition. Measurement is based on 3 pillars – leadership, community and performance. The award also takes into consideration increases in participation, public interest in the sport, and elite success.

- Harry Fairchild becoming the world's first qualified Table Tennis Coach with Downs syndrome
