The practice match has been arranged by the 2018 WTTC Halmstad organisation and will start at 10.45am (UK time) on Monday 22 May.

Taking place behind closed doors at Halmstad Theatre in Sweden, the format is unusual, with matches over two games and the result depending on the total games won by each country.

The match takes place during a training camp for this year's World Championships, which get underway in Düsseldorf on 29th May.
