

REPORTING CONCERNS OF POSSIBLE ABUSE FROM OUTSIDE TABLE TENNIS

If you are concerned that a child could be being abused outside of the table tennis setting

If the child requires immediate medical attention, call an ambulance and inform the doctor that there is a child protection concern

Report your concern to the Club/League Welfare Officer and/or National Equality and Child Protection Officer who will refer the matter to the Police or Children's Social Care without delay. Make a record of anything the child has said or what you have seen with dates and times

If the Club/League Welfare Officer or the National Equality and Child Protection Officer are not available then refer the matter immediately to the Police or Children's Social Care WITHOUT DELAY

Discuss with the Police or Children's Social Care whether it is appropriate to discuss the matter with the child's parents/carers

Complete the ETTA's Incident Report Form and send it to the National Child Protection Officer and make available to the statutory agencies if required
