Regulations for Banded Events

- Subject to the conditions set out below, a Tournament may run events from which players above **and** below certain rating points totals are excluded, the criteria being determined by the ratings shown on the National Rating List.
- Events run under these Regulations shall be called "Banded Events" and be called "Band 1 Men's Singles", "Band 2 Women's Singles", "Band 3 Boys Singles", etc. as appropriate.
- The Tournament Organising Committee can choose appropriate limits for the banded events (unless the tournament is part of the Grand Prix Tournament circuit, in which case, you MUST follow the declared Bands as published by the Table Tennis England Office). If you are not included within the Grand Prix circuit, these "Bands" can vary from one tournament to another and should be clearly indicated on the entry form e.g. "between 1000 and 1499", "between 1600 and 1899", etc, or lower than "1000", etc, or higher than "1000", etc.
- The entry form for a Banded event shall include the following statement:

 "To be eligible to enter the appropriate event a player shall, at the closing date of entries, have a rating within the range set for the chosen Band."
- 5 The various events should be seeded according to the Rating Lists in the usual way.
