Regulations for Team Events

- 1 A team event may be held in conjunction with an Open Tournament or may be part of or constitute a Team Tournament.
- 2 A team event, whether or not held in conjunction with an Open Tournament, may be either open or by invitation. If by invitation regulations for Invitation Tournaments apply.
- 3 Details of the system of play shall be stated in the Entry Form, including
 - 1) the number of players in a team
 - 2) whether the same players must play in all matches and, if not, the maximum size of the squad
 - 3) whether additional player(s) may play in the doubles
 - 4) the number of individual matches in a team match
 - 5) whether a team match is to finish when a result is reached
 - 6) the order of play, specifying the type of event (eg. Men's Singles, Men's Doubles, etc)
- 4 The Entry Form must indicate whether the event is to be run on a knockout or group basis.
- 5 A team event may be seeded at the discretion of the Organising Committee.
- 6 Such of the Tournament Regulations as are appropriate to a team event, and are applicable to the grade of Tournament in conjunction with which the team event is being run, shall apply. In the case of a Team Event not run in conjunction with an Open Tournament, the applicable Regulations shall be those appropriate to a Team Event run in conjunction with a 2-Star Tournament.
