<p>ETTA Introduction to Table Tennis Award – 3 Hours</p> <p>This course is suitable for anyone wanting to learn about the sport of table tennis for the first time. It is mainly a practical course with some theory which provides an introduction to starter table tennis skills. <p>ETTA Introduction to Coaching Award – 6 Hours</p> <p>This award is suitable for parents, sixth formers, candidates for the Duke of Edinburgh's Award, table tennis players or those who work within the youth or leisure/sport services. It is mainly a practical course with some theory, and provides an introduction to table tennis coaching. The aims of the course are to: Enable participants to organise safe, enjoyable and purposeful table tennis activities; Enable participants to organise suitable competitive games for their players; Inform participants about further opportunities for their pupils to take part in table tennis in the community as officials, umpires and coaches through further Coach Education courses provided by the ETTA.</p>	<p>ETTA Introduction to Coaching Awards Handbook; ETTA Laws of Table Tennis leaflet; ETTA Junior Umpire Award Leaflet; ETTA Child Protection Policy & Guidelines; ETTA Disability Awareness Manual. <p>ETTA Teacher Award – 6 Hours</p> <p>This award is suitable for qualified or student teachers. It is mainly a practical course with some theory, and provides an introduction to table tennis coaching. The aims of the course are to: Enable Teachers to organise safe, enjoyable and purposeful table tennis activities suitable for use in their school; Enable Teachers to organise suitable competitions for their pupils; Inform teachers about further opportunities for their pupils to take part in table tennis in the community as officials, umpires and coaches through TT Networker and Coach Education courses provided by the ETTA.</p>	<p>ETTA Teachers Awards Handbook; ETTA Laws of Table Tennis leaflet; ETTA Junior Umpire Award Leaflet; ETTA Child Protection Policy & Guidelines; ETTA Disability Awareness Manual. 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<p>ETTA Young TT Networker Award (Youth Leadership Award) – 6 Hours</p> <p>This practically based course aimed at 15-19 year olds can be delivered as a bolt on to the Community Sports Leaders Award (CSLA), or as a stand alone course. The course aims are to:</p> <p>1. Enable Young TT Networkers (leaders) to organise, safe, enjoyable and purposeful Table Tennis activities aimed primarily at young people. 2. Provide a lead into Table Tennis coaching, organising competitions, umpiring, table tennis development and an awareness of table tennis for all.</p>	<p>Young TT Networker Handbook including: Warm up/Warm down exercises, Basic Technique and Coaching sheets (grip, stance, four basic strokes, service) Competition Formats (top table, group and draw sheets, ladder example), Table Tennis in England, Selling Points of Table Tennis, Where next Club contacts, Task assessment sheets/log, Handbook, ETTA Law booklet Skills Awards and Junior Umpire Award Level 1. Dates and Times

The following are some examples for scheduling courses:

3 hour course 1 day 3:30pm to 7:30pm or 7:00pm to 10:00pm.

6 hour course 1 day 10:00am to 4:30pm or 3 day, twilight or early evening.

Resources

The closing date should be 2 weeks prior to the first day of the course to enable the resource packs to be delivered in time.

The ETTA will invoice the organising body for any resource packs ordered but not used on the day. If you do not wish to keep the packs for future courses an admin fee of £10.00 will be required to take packs back into stock.

Promotion

The ETTA can provide a personalised course leaflet, which includes a registration form. The course can also be publicised through ETTA Ezine bulletins and website. If you wish to produce your own leaflet a separate course registration form must be signed by each course candidate by the course closing date.

Costs

All the course fees are shown overleaf. If there is a venue costs this needs to be added to the costs per head.

Where organised by a LA, Sports College or School, the tutor & assessor should be paid directly (Introduction to Coaching Award course and above). For all other organising groups the ETTA will invoice the organising body for their fees and the resource pack costs.
