I was so pleased to be there on this occasion as Chair of our national governing body and I intend to work with our Board, senior management team, staff, players and volunteers to make table tennis a sport for the future. Appointments of New Non-Executive Directors
Part of these changes is the actual governance the ETTA, that is the way the ETTA has run itself to date and the way we will do so in the future. We have already recruited a new senior management team to take over a more focused, structured and dynamic organisation. Now we look to ourselves. In keeping with the recommendations of an independent review and supported by our financial backers, Sport England, our next phase of change will be the creation of a newly structured Board of Directors.

It is proposed that the new Board will comprise the three Elected Directors (Chairman, Deputy Chairman and Treasurer), the Chief Executive Officer and up to another eight Directors.

The Directors will have a wide variety of skills, experience and expertise between them.
