

## PREMIERCLUB STAR RATING CRITERIA

The PremierClub programme has introduced a new way to assess table tennis clubs that are part of the PremierClub programme. Clubmark Accreditation is a cross sport bench mark that shows that a club offers its members a safe and secure environment to play sport. Table Tennis England recognises that many clubs offer their members much more than the basic criteria set out by Clubmark.

The Star Rating has been introduced to show potential club members what a club offers, provide official NGB recognition of the best clubs in England and to encourage clubs to grow by providing an analysis of their offer.

Clubs are asked to complete a self assessment form so Table Tennis England can make its assessment. The form is broken down into four sections:

- **Section 1: Your Achievements** – Allows a club to showcase the work it does in its local community, through promotion of table tennis or hosting of events, plus recognition for supporting Table Tennis England initiatives such as Ability Club, Change 4 Life etc.
- **Section 2: Your Club:** Looks at the clubs’ coaching staff, membership and volunteer structure as well as links with other organisations.
- **Section 3: Your Venue:** Focuses on opening hours, facilities and equipment.
- **Section 4: Your Programmes:** Looks at the clubs’ coaching programme, league and competition entry.
