TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS & INFORMATION

1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Player Member to the ETTA Ltd or of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.

2. ETTA tournament Regulations apply for this tournament including Regulation R (Racket Re-Rubbering). ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply except those relating to matters covered by items marked with (x) in this entry form.

3. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signify agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including the variations from the ITTF requirements.

4. All competitors will be required to umpire at least one match in event entered.

5. All players are eligible to compete in the Open event. No player can play both events. The Secondary event is open to all ages and both sexes but only to players with no more than 400 ranking points on the junior, senior or veterans ETTA lists at the closing date.

6. Main events will take place over two days.

Main Event

The top 16 seeds in the main event will receive byes to the 2nd days groups. 14 players from the qualifying Main event will join the main event on the second day.

Ladies Event

Top 8 ladies seeds will receive byes to the 2nd days groups. 8 players from the Ladies Qualifying will join the Ladies event on the second day.

Vets Event (Competitors must over 40 years of age on 1st January 2012)

Dependent on entries qualifying groups will be played on the 1st day going through to Vets 2nd stage groups on the second day. Any seeds receiving byes is dependent on entries.

7. All matches shall be the best of five games to eleven points. Play throughout will be on a knockout basis with the exception of preliminary rounds, which will be on a group basis. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5. for Group competitions.

8. Players clothing: ETTA Appendix 'C' to Rules will apply (x).

9. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.

10. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.

11. All competitors must, report to the control on arrival and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.

12. Should there be insufficient entries in any event the Referee reserves the right to cancel that event/merge such event and /or place the entrant in a similar event.

13. The referee's decision shall be final on points of law, and any question arising not provided for in these regulations or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof. Decisions on points of fact by an umpire or assistant umpire appointed by the Referee shall be final.

14. No refunds will be given after the date of the draw.

15. Entry Form - Further entry forms are available from, and should be returned to, Mr Gary Wilson, 4 St Stephens Hill, St Stephens, Saltash, Cornwall PL124AR. Cheques and postal orders should be made payable to Woolwell Table Tennis Club. Entries without fees will not be accepted. The last date for receipt of entries is 4th December 2012.

16. Entries - If it is necessary to restrict entries this will be done on the bases of the last received, first out with the exception that men ranked in the ETTA Top 100 and Women in the Top 16, and unranked players considered by the tournament committee to be of an equivalent standard, will be guaranteed entry if entries are received by the deadline.

17. Draw - The draw will take place on 7th December 2012.

18. Admission - There will be a £2 charge for spectators which will include a programme and raffle ticket. No charge for competitors.

19. Playing Conditions - Play throughout in the main and plate events will be on 7 Joola tables with J Joola 3* white balls, specialist sports flooring and ETTA approved lighting a minimum of 5m above the table. Court size will be 9m x 5m minimum enclosed by surrounds.

20. Doping - Doping control tests may take place.

21. Practice - There will be no separate practice facilities. Competitors will be permitted to practice on tables not in use at the discretion of the Referee. These will be available for one hour before play commences each day and also until 10pm on 28th December.

22. Car Parking - Car Parking (at owners risk) is available at the venue.

23. Changing facilities with showers are available.

24. A two course buffet evening dinner will be available at the venue shortly after the completion of play on 28th December. This can be booked at the time of entry or (subject to available places) up to one week before the event, by which time a full menu will be available.

25. Notification - Competitors will be notified of the time of their first match, together with directions to the venue either by email or post (in which case a stamped addressed envelope must be enclosed.)
