Welcome to the ETTA Coaching Awards 2012/13. These awards are designed to recognise, celebrate and reward examples of outstanding coaching in table tennis. In a change to previous years the ETTA has decided to hold both Regional and National Awards. This means that each of the 10 ETTA Regions will recognise winners at local level, with a National Young Coach & Coach of the Year selected from the 10 Regional category winners. HOW TO MAKE A NOMINATION

Anyone involved with table tennis or in partnership with the sport can nominate an individual for any of the categories the nominee is eligible for.

In order to nominate a coach please complete all parts of the nomination form overleaf and return the nomination form to your regional coach. Please note that should you require more space you can complete additional supporting evidence on a separate sheet of paper and attach it to the nomination form (photocopies of the form are acceptable).

CATEGORIES & NOMINATION CRITERIA

Nominees for both categories must hold an ETTA Coach Licence. Any person who qualifies for the Young Coach of the Year category can also be nominated for the Coach of the Year.

1. Coach of the Year

This award recognises the outstanding contribution of the coach to get more people starting to play, and developing players to reach their potential in table tennis, through high quality coaching.

Specific Criteria

Essential

- Evidence of creativity and determination in their development as a coach.
- Evidence of the provision of opportunities and dedicated support to performers to help them reach their goals.
- Evidence of the development of basic skills.
- Evidence of appropriate quality coaching.
- Evidence of the impact that the coach has had on widening access to table tennis through quality coaching.
- Evidence of player focused coaching enabling the performers to reach their full potential.
- Showing good communication and organisation in their coaching delivery and preparation
- Showing courage & honesty, being ethical in their coaching practice
- Showing compassion to work with others and adapt sessions

- Reflecting on their coaching philosophy and evaluating their coaching behaviours/values/practices

Desirable

- Evidence of national or international achievements by players coached
- Examples/evidence of innovative practice.
- Motivating and promoting young people to play and coach

2. Young Coach of the Year

This award recognises the important work carried out by up and coming coaches through their coaching achievements to date.

Specific Criteria (additional to those for Coach of the Year)

- Nominees for this award must be 25yrs or under.
