Tournament details: Players will be ranked 1-32 based on current computer points and their known playing standard. Players all take part in 5 matches resulting in everyone finishing with a rating from 1 – 32. [see further details in 'general information'].

Tournament Regulations & Conditions:

- *This event is open to all male and female players – NO age restriction.
- *Every entrant **MUST** have a TTE player membership, or be a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
- *TTE Tournament Regulations apply to this tournament.
- * ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply except those relating to the matters covered by items marked (x) in this entry form.
- *Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the regulations and conditions of this competition.
- * Entries - Entry forms must be submitted with full payment of fees.
- *Each match will consist of best of 5 games, each game up to 11 points with a 2 point difference to decide the winner.
- *All players will be expected to umpire throughout the evening.
- *The main colour of clothing must be different from the colour of the ball.
- *Players will be expected to play when called, so do not leave the venue at any time without the organiser's permission.
- ***ALL** players will be expected to honour fully their playing and umpiring commitments/obligations.
- * If you enter and subsequently are unable to play, you **MUST** notify the organiser as soon as you know that you cannot attend as a reserve player can be arranged. Someone not turning up on the day without notification can disrupt and spoil it for everybody
- *All fees are non-refundable unless otherwise stated.
- *No competitor or Official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- *Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
- *'Knocking' on vacant tables between matches will be at the discretion of the organiser(s)/referee(s).

Playing Conditions:

- *Play will be on 8 Donic tables with Donic posts and nets.
- *Each table will be in an individual court enclosed by surrounds.
- *Each court will be 4.5 metres wide by 10 metres in length.
- *Minimum height of playing area is 6 metres.
- *Minimum height of lighting from floor is 5 metres
- *Lighting is general LED.
- *Flooring, semi-sprung timber.
- *There are no practice facilities.

General Information:

- *Score machines will be used for all matches.
- *Balls used will be white plastic Donic 3*.
- *Doping control tests may take place.
- *The playing structure is aimed at 32 players each playing 5 games per tournament. If you win you move up the draw; if you lose you move down. Everyone finishes with a tournament rating from 1- 32.

If less than 32 players attend a similar format will be used but some players will only have 4 matches.

Total prize fund on the night is £625
