TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS (to be retained)

- Every entrant must be affiliated as a Player Member to Table Tennis England, or another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
- All entries must hold a valid Table Tennis England Player License or have paid the appropriate Single Competition License Fee with their entry form unless he/she provides proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and is not affiliated to Table Tennis England
- Table Tennis England Tournament Regulations apply to this tournament.
- Competitors will not be allowed to glue up within the confines of any of the buildings under any circumstances.
- ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply except those relating to matters covered by items marked (x) in the entry form.
- Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the Entrant to the conditions of the Competition including variations from ITTF requirements.
- All matches shall be the best of five games. Preliminary matches will be on a group basis. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions.
- Players' Clothing: Main colour of clothing must be different from colour of ball (x).
- No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
- All competitors will be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
- Doping shall not take place either before or during play and doping control tests may take place.
- All Competitors must report to the Booking-In Control on arrival and should not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
- Should there be insufficient entries in any event the Referee reserves the right to cancel that event/merge such event and/or place the entrant in a similar event.
- The referee's decision shall be final on a point of law and on any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof.
- Players must have been born in 1997 or later for the junior event, 2000 cadet, 2002 under 13 & 2004 under 11.

No entry will be accepted unless the following undertaking is signed:

- To observe the regulations of the tournament.
- To abide by the decisions of the Referee and Organising Committee.
- To fulfill the schedule of play arranged for me unless prevented by circumstances beyond my control and accepted as such by the Referee.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- Entry forms - Further entry forms are available from, and should be returned to Malcolm Macfarlane, 36 Crown Way, Lillington, Leamington Spa, CV32 7SE to arrive not later than 18th September 2015. There is a limit of 2 events any one player can enter. The draw will take place on the 21st September at 36 Crown Way, Lillington, Leamington Spa at 10am. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, this will be on the basis of last received first out.
- Practice - There will be no separate practice facilities. Competitors will be allowed to practice on tables not in use at the discretion of the referee.
- Play will be on up to 15 Donic Tables with Donic nets and White 3* 40+ balls. Court size will be 9m x 4.5m (x) enclosed by surrounds. Scoring machines will be used for all matches. The floor is a semi sprung wood floor. General fluorescent lighting is a minimum 7m above the table. Assistant umpires will not be appointed.
- Tea and Coffee will be available at the venue. Car parking (at the owners risk) is available at the venue. Admission - there will be no admission charge. Changing facilities including showers are available.
- Trophies will be presented to all winners and runners-up.
- Players should retain this sheet of regulations and information.
- No refunds of entry fees will be made after the date of the draw.
