

# **Veteran National Championships**

## Competition proposal

#### Overview

Following the Competition Review Groups decision to omit the Veteran's element from the Senior National Championships for the 2015/16 season and onwards, Table Tennis England have proposed having a Veteran only National Championships. The competition would be called the Veteran National Championships and would be held once a season.

#### **Format**

The competition would consist of the following events and number of entrants:

Men's Singles - 64

Women's Singles - 32

Men's Doubles – 16 pairs

Women's Doubles - 8 pairs

Mixed Doubles – 16 pairs

Singles will be played in groups of four. The top two will progress to the main draw and the bottom two to the consolation event. After the group stages a knock out system will take effect. All matches will be played to the best of five ends.

Doubles will be a straight knock out system. All matches will be played to the best of five ends.

### Schedule

The competition would be played on one day only. For the 2015/16 season Table Tennis England are proposing one of the following dates; Friday 8<sup>th</sup> July 2016, Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> July 2016 or Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> July 2016.
