- 2. Eight events Boys under 19, 16, 13 and 11, and Girls under 19, 16, 13, and 11. Ages as at 31st August/1st September 2015. Players may enter ONE EVENT only.
- 3. Suitable sports wear MUST (be worn. NO WHITE CLOTHING. Tracksuit trousers not to be worn during play.
- 4. Entries to the Organiser by Friday, 29 January 2016.
- 5. Bring your own bats. Balls will be provided.
- 6. No entries will be accepted unless accompanied by the appropriate entry fee. The cost is £3 per player for this local part of the competition only. Only the winning players go through by right to the next stage of the National competition being held in April with winning schools teams being responsible for the entry fee (£24 per player made payable to the ESTTA).
