TOURNAMENT INFORMATION:

1. Entries must be RECEIVED WITH PAYMENT by Rory Scott, Lyons Holding, Lyons Road, Slinfold, West Sussex, RH13 0TD by no later than Friday 24th June 2016. If no email address given, then you will need to contact the referee to get confirmation your entry has been received.
2. Emailed entries will be accepted with entry form as an attachment & accompanied by payment by bank transfer. See below for bank account details:

3. The draw will be held on Thursday 30th June 2016.
4. If it is necessary to restrict entries, restriction will be on the basis of last received, first out.
5. The planned format is mainly groups of 4, but there may be some groups of 3 players. In all events, after the initial group stage, there will be main draw & consolation draw knock-outs. The format may be varied at the discretion of the Referee.
6. There will be medals for the winners, runners-up & 3rd place in the main draw of each age group (except no bronze medals in any category with less than 7 entries).
7. Entries may be limited to 63 players for each session (i.e. morning & afternoon sessions). The format may be varied at the discretion of the referee.
8. Late entries will ONLY be accepted if there is still space in the draw.
9. Competitors will be informed by email that their entry has been received at least 3 days before the event. If you have not heard from anything by this time, please get in touch with the referee.
10. Cold drinks & tea/coffee as well as snacks & sandwiches will be available for purchase from the Referee. There is ample free parking. There are changing room facilities too.
11. Play will take place on 9 Butterfly tables with Butterfly nets and posts and with Donic/Joola scoring machines.
12. Yasaka 3 star Seamed Poly (plastic) white balls will be used.
13. Tables will be individually courted. Min ceiling height: 5m; Court Size: Minimum 9m X 5m.
14. Lighting is general & fluorescent. Light intensity is minimum 300 lux.
15. The venue has sprung flooring.
16. There will be no admission charge.
17. The results from this tournament will qualify for computer ranking points.
18. No refunds can be given after the closing date.
19. The Entry Form will incorporate an Undertaking as follows:-
 1. To observe the regulations of the tournament.
 2. To abide by the decisions of the Referee.
 3. To fulfil the schedule of play arranged unless prevented by circumstances beyond control and accepted as such.

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS:

1. Table Tennis England Tournament Regulations apply to this tournament. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply.
2. Every entrant must be Affiliated to Table Tennis England or be a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
3. Every player must hold a valid Table Tennis England Player Licence or have paid the appropriate Single Tournament Licence Fee with their entry form unless he/she provides proof of being a member of another National Association affiliated to the ITTF and is not affiliated to Table Tennis England.
4. Completion and submission of this entry form signify agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including variations from the ITTF requirements and to the storage of information about the competitor on a computer system.
5. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5. The format may be varied at the discretion of the Referee.
6. **Competitors may enter 1 or 2 events. If playing in 2 events, it must be one morning event & one afternoon event.** See page 1 for schedule.
7. Competitors must report to Control on arrival, and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
8. The Referee reserves the right to cancel/merge events if entry levels are low.
9. There will be no separate practice facilities. Competitors will be permitted to practice on match tables at the discretion of the Referee.
10. All competitors will be required to umpire matches.
11. Clothing must be different to the colour of the ball, which will be white.
12. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
13. No gluing up will be allowed in the building.
14. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
15. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England computer-ranking scheme.
16. Competitors must have been born in 2005 or later for under 11's, 2004 or later for under 12's, 2003 or later for under 13's, 2002 or later for under 14's, 2001 or later for under 15's and 1998 or later for under 18's.
